Our Recipe For Saving Lives

Begin with a large scoop of hard-working volunteers, mix in a large dollop of generous donors, simmer in a broth of dedicated veterinarians, vet techs, & groomers, and there you have it! Since 2004, we have rescued

enough, but it's hard work, and dogs in need are NEVER in short supply. Coming to us from shelters, backyard breeders, puppy mills, or surrendered by owners, these poodles and poo-mixes are often neglected, abused, sick, &

frightened. Many have an unknown history, so we start with the basics: off to the vet for a thorough checkup; spayed or neutered; microchipped; and blood work to

check for heartworms or any other health problems.

Medications prescribed, flea & heartworm protection
applied & perhaps a trip to the groomer for a badly
needed bath and a haircut. Oh, but we're not done yet!

We place the dog in a loving foster home so they can settle in & be assessed. We never euthanize! Some dogs become "permanent fosters" due to health or temperament concerns & live out their days in loving foster care. Many hours & dollars go into this wonderful

effort, but there's more! Adoption applications must be checked, & the best possible Forever Home found for these beautiful & healthy dogs.
